We will never turn away any ACFJC client or potential client based on their race, gender, religion, nationality, sexual orientation, gender identity, or immigration status. The ACFJC does not conduct criminal background checks. We do not ask people about their immigration or naturalization status and we do not report to US Immigration & Customs Enforcement (ICE) or any other federal agency, and we will keep your information confidential to the extent the law allows unless you tell us otherwise.

Our only goal is to help people be safe, to receive the services they and their children and families need and to provide opportunities for our clients to move forward, be empowered, and thrive in a safe and healthy community.
